2023 sees new additions to some of your favourite children's book series from Graffeg, along with a few fantastic new titles.

The seventh title in the Animal Surprises series by Nicola Davies and Abbie Cameron looks at some of the reptiles found across the world in easy-to-read rhyming prose.

A new series by Marielle Bayliss and Mariela Malova tells the story of Frog, who is struggling to find a perfect place to relax but his friends the bees know a way they can help.

The adventures of Albert the Tortoise from Ian Brown and Eoin Clarke see the real-life minidinosaur living life on the veg for a fifth and sixth picture books, *Albert and the Pond* and *Albert and the Shed.* Ian and Eoin also continue the adventures of Hugg 'n' Bugg, where the messy yeti seemingly abandons his new friend when he finds a comb on a journey down the mountain.

A new format and a new story by Julie Rudi and Tiphanie Beeke see Graffeg enter the world of board books. *That's How Much I Love You* is a brilliant rhyming story about parental love, perfect for ages 0-3. Graffeg also introduces a number of it's favourite picture book characters to this new format, including Albert the Tortoise and Fletcher.

A Zoo in my Shoe combines a second humorous rhyming text exploring the power of language by BBC broadcaster Jason Korsner and giggle-inducing illustrations by Max Low.

With previous title *Leap*, *Hare*, *Leap!* having been nominated for the CILIP Kate Greenaway and Carnegie medal, the Wild Wanderers series continues with its sixth title, *Fly*, *Butterfly*, *Fly!* which inspires wonder and engagement with the natural world through Dom Conlon's lyrical text and Anastasia Izlesou's enchanting illustrations.

Finally, Jon Roberts and Hannah Rounding return with a new picture book exploring autism and the role of assistance dogs in *The Torch*, a coastal adventure story featuring Lily and her assistance dog, Myles.

Goodbye Hobbs author Emma Bettridge's second picture book, *Red is Home*, looks at the emotions associated with moving home, illustrated by Josephine Birch.

Debut picture book author Isla McGuckin teams up with experienced illustrator Catalina Echeverri for *April's Garden*, a gentle story about a family living in temporary accommodation and how April uses gardening as a way to control her complicated feelings about the situation.

We also have new additions to our Mouse and Moles series, as well as new activity and colouring books.
