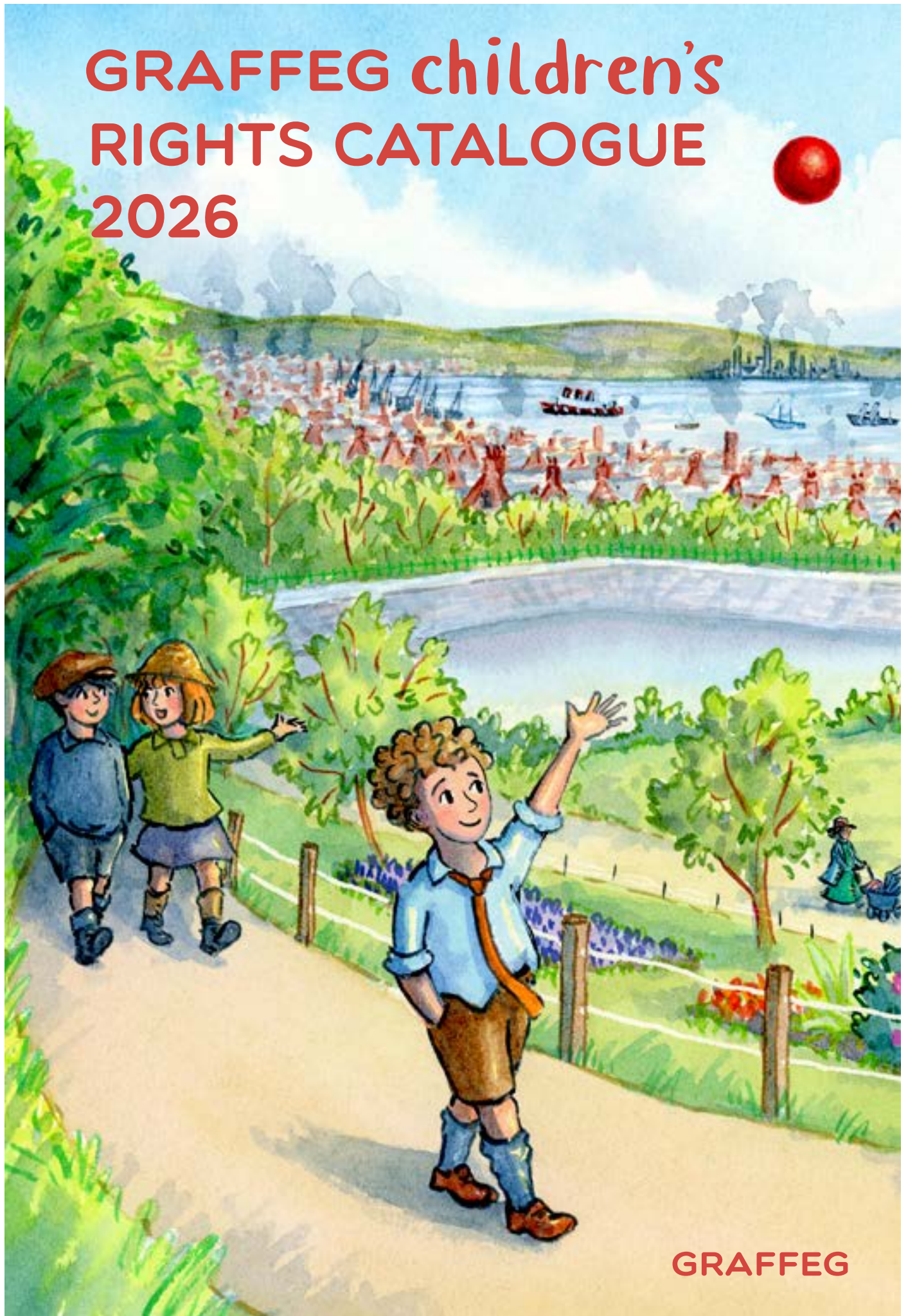

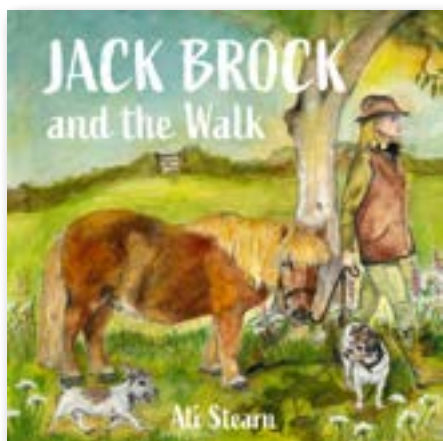

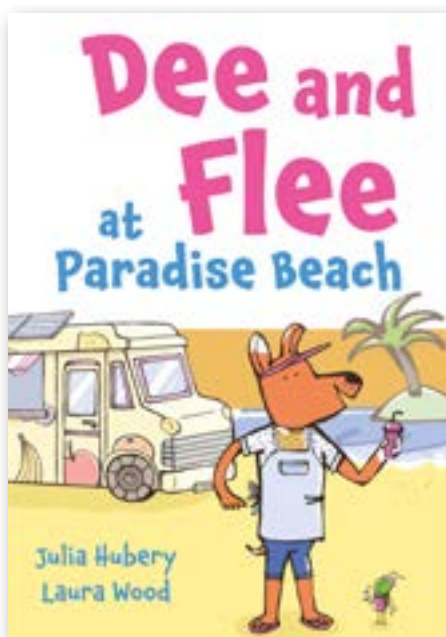
Sample text:
